### Goal of the Position:

### Scope of the Position:

As an Impact Team member, you will have a short term, high impact role in key decisions. United Way investments change lives for the better in a myriad of ways, and shape the communities in which we live. Your contribution is recognized as extremely important to our collective success. Impact Team members work closely with their Team Leader and the United Way Staff. Each Impact Team typically has 3 members including the leader.

### Core Responsibilities

- Take part in interviews/presentations from assigned applicant organizations/charities.
- Expand your personal understanding of United Way's role in communities and the work of local charities.
- Use the Assessment Tool to score the organization, provide written feedback and help make a funding recommendation.

### Commitment:

- ✚ The work of Impact Teams will take place April to June 2019
- ✚ 2 hours for training and orientation (April 25th)
- ✚ 9-12 hours total reviewing applications, meeting organizations to review their projects, and completing assessments (April-May).

### Skills Required:

- ✚ Ability to lead, coordinate and collaborate with others.
- ✚ A keen eye to task management and detail.
- ✚ Understanding of social issues is an asset.
- ✚ Knowledge of financial management is an asset.
- ✚ Professionalism and strong communication skills.
- ✚ Willingness to act as an Ambassador on behalf of the United Way
- ✚ Ability to be decisive.
